• **Application fee:** All applicants must go through the admissions interview and possible testing. This is a one-time fee of **\$150.00**

• **Enrollment fee:** Annual fee of **\$832.00** to enroll in class.

• **Capital Fee :** The school has a one-time admission fee of **\$10,000.00**.

The Capital Fee for students applying to Secondary (7th to 12th Grade) is **\$7,000.00**

This may be paid up front with a discount or deferred up to three years.

Learning-Technology Resources: All school supplies, books, notebooks, use of technology, online access to educational platforms are provided by the school. The fee varies from each section:

ENROLLMENT COSTS, TUITION AND OTHER EXPENSES

These are the Boston School International fees, payment methods and additional expenses.

Payment Methods:

1. Annual Tuition - Must be paid before June 30 before the academic year starts. This payment method offers a 5% discount on the total payment of the Annual Tuition.
2. Monthly Tuition - 10 monthly installments from the month of beginning of classes, from August 1st to May 30. Payment must be made during the first 10 days of each month, if made after that date a surcharge of 10% of the value of the fee will be charged. If the 10th of the month coincides with a holiday or national day, you must pay the monthly payment the previous business day, so the surcharge does not apply.

Registration Fees must be paid by June 30 of each year to complete the Registration or re-enrollment process.

Registration will depend on the timeliness of payments and available spaces. The spots available for the result of incomplete registrations will be offered to the aspiring students.

Enrollment:

Enrollment includes the following, among others:

- Accident insurance
- Access to school facilities
- First aid service by our qualified nurse
- Ambulance service

Additional Resources for the Teaching-Learning Process:

Additional resources in the Teaching-Learning process are any material, equipment, project, 1 tool, academic tour, academic activity, leisure activity, such as academic programs and resources, digital and/or physical books, school supplies, technology equipment, digital applications, licenses, assessment platforms, lab equipment, scientific calculators, robotics equipment, among others, that serve to develop and enrich the students, favoring the process and facilitating the interpretation of content that the teacher has to teach.

Other Expenses:

- The School will charge thirty-five dollars (\$ 35.00) for a returned check.
- The school reserves the right to invoice, to the student's account, the costs caused by the loss, destruction or damage of the materials and books of the library, supplies or equipment of the school.
- The ninth grade Graduation Fee is two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), to be paid along with the Registration Fee.
- The twelfth grade Graduation Fee is three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00), to be paid along with the Registration Fees. In addition, a \$75 deposit applies for gown rental, of which \$50.00 is refunded at the time of return.
- ESL Service - Monthly cost of two hundred dollars (200.00).
- Special Needs (Cost as appropriate)
- Student withdrawal credits, fifty dollars (50.00).
- Study Certifications and reprints of newsletters, five dollars (5.00).
- Extracurricular Services, (Cost according to activity).
- Leveling, validation, Remedial courses/ exams.
- Academic Tours outside of Panama City.
